



The Macduff Family Itinerary

An itinerary aimed at younger visitors, full of education history and fun in the coastal town of Macduff.

1. Macduff Marine Aquarium

Situated on High Shore, the aquarium's deep central exhibit tank, which displays a living kelp reef, is the only one of its kind in Britain and divers hand feed the fish on a regular basis. Owned by Aberdeenshire Council, Macduff Marine Aquarium aims to promote awareness, enjoyment and stewardship of the Moray Firth marine environment in an entertaining and educational way. If you love your visit then you can adopt an animal for a year. You can give your animal a name and you will receive a certificate of adoption. A plaque will be mounted near the animal's tank. You will also receive the aquarium's quarterly newsletter "Flotsam and Jetsam". Super-Adopters' donating over £50 for their adoption will receive a complementary family ticket to visit their animal.

2. Harley's Soft Play and Ten Pin Bowling

Only a short walk from the aquarium you will find Harley's Soft Play and Ten Pin Bowling on Old Gamrie Road. While the kids run wild in the soft play, parents can relax in the redesigned restaurant and enjoy a great cup of coffee and a sticky bun. After all the excitement of bowling and soft play why not have a spot of lunch. All meals are homemade from scratch so any allergies can be catered for.

3. Puffin Cruises

End your day of activity with a trip out on the ocean with Puffin Cruises. They offer daily sightseeing and fishing trips from Macduff Harbour at the fish market jetty, along the scenic Moray Firth coastline which has an abundance of sea and bird life that includes puffins, whales and dolphins.
